The HIFU procedure takes place in Doctors Hospital, an acute care hospital that strives to exceed the needs of patients while providing a professional and rewarding environment for physicians. This is a private hospital with experienced staff devoted to providing HIFU while you are there.

The day before the procedure the patient will meet with a HIFU Team Member to go over instructions for the day of the procedure and what to expect after HIFU. This meeting will take place at Doctors Hospital in the main lobby the night before the procedure. **The patient will need to take a taxi from the hotel to the hospital.** This should be a 15 minute taxi ride that costs \$15-20 (US) depending on the time of day.

On the day of the procedure the patient is picked up from the hotel and transported to the hospital. Upon arrival at the hospital, they will enter a small waiting area where they should wait until they are assisted by a HIFU nurse. During the procedure, spouses/partners or friends who accompany the patient will wait in the waiting area until the procedure is over and the patient is in recovery. We recommend bringing magazines or books to read while waiting. After the procedure and recovery, the patient is transported back to the hotel to recover more comfortably.

Travel by Air

Nassau Paradise Island is conveniently located just a short flight away from several major US cities. **You will need a valid passport to travel to the Bahamas.** Please make sure your passport is updated and does not expire within 6 months of the day you plan to travel. Nassau International Airport (NAS) lies 10 miles (16k.m.) from downtown Nassau.

Travel by Taxi

Taxis are plentiful at Nassau International Airport and offer an economical way to get downtown. Taxis directly to your hotel will take 20- 30 minutes and cost \$25-35 US depending on the number of passengers and baggage. All taxis are metered. Check that the driver activates the meter or confirm the fare before departing the airport. If you would like to arrange for a car service instead you can call Romeos Executive Limo at 242-361-4741. The estimated cost for a sedan is \$80 (US) and \$100 (US) for a limo.

Getting around Nassau / Paradise Island is very easy. Metered taxis are located outside the hotels and may also be hired by the hour. Please be aware that they do drive on the left side of the road!

Things to See & Do in Nassau

Nassau, located on Paradise Island of the Bahamas, is a beautiful destination with a lot to offer if you are interested in extending your stay or checking out some of the sites during your stay. The official language is English and Bahamian dollar is on par with the US dollar. They are both used interchangeably. You may choose to spend some extra time strolling the cobblestone streets, splashing around in the clear turquoise waters or shopping for traditional Bahamian handicrafts.
